 - b. If the contractor uncovers or identifies any buried lines not shown, the contractor shall immediately notify the MSFC Facilities Engineering Department prior to proceeding.
 - c. The Contractor shall be responsible for alerting personnel, including subcontractor personnel, that the site of the work is located on a former ordnance installation. Although there is no record that the work site described above was ever used as a disposal area for explosive items or toxic materials, personnel should be apprised of this fact and in the event old shells, mortars, or other explosive components or suspect materials are encountered in the area, these items should not be handled or subjected to any physical abuse. The Contractor shall cease work and evacuate the area and notify the fire department (911) and Facilities Engineering Department representative immediately upon detection of such items in order that specialized government personnel may safely remove these hazards.
 - d. No trenchers shall be used on MSFC without prior approval by the COTR.
 - e. Do not cut any underground line until it is identified by the Facilities Engineering Department.
 - f. No tie-ins or connections are to be performed on natural gas lines or propane lines within 500 feet of occupied building during normal working hours (7:00 am - 4:30 pm).
