FOR: International Shipping, U.S. Postal Services, FAX, E-Mail or Internet Transfer of All Commodities, Technology, Software and Technical Data.

When necessary, consult with the Center Export Representative (CER) at least 6 weeks prior to requesting international export services and prior to exporting via any mode. (Note: Exports that are "public domain" technical data, general correspondence for program management, or non-technical information require less time.)

Complete an ECIS for each international export. Send one copy to Assistant CEA, VS01. CER retains original in ECIS file for 6 years.
